Research Overview

Dr. Rogers believes that study of the neurodevelopmental outcomes of NICU graduates grounds the care of infants in the Intensive Care Nursery. Her current interests are in defining the outcomes of the "new" prematurity, with an increased number of premature infants born to mothers of advanced maternal age, with chronic disease and preeclampsia, and conceived through assisted reproductive technologies. She recently received a pediatric fellowship grant from MedImmune, Inc. for her work studying the outcomes of premature infants conceived by ART.
